

CIVIL PROJECT ENGINEER

The Urban Drainage and Flood Control District, a regional government agency in the Denver, Colorado area, has an immediate opening in its Design, Construction, and Maintenance Program for a full-time permanent position. The individual will perform a variety of professional functions relating to the Design, Construction and Maintenance Program including project management; and extensive contact with local government officials, consulting engineers, and contractors.

Duties will include assisting the Assistant Program Manager in preparing project cost estimates for programming and budgeting; preparation of intergovernmental agreements for funding of projects; recommendation of approval of acquisitions, secures appraisals for rights-of-way, arranges for rights-of-way negotiations, and handles condemnation proceedings as necessary; under direction of the Assistant Program Manager prepares the scope of project and selects, negotiates, and recommends contracts with consulting engineers for design projects; reviews and approves proposed plans for construction to insure compliance with District criteria and for feasibility of construction; administers construction contracts, including the bidding and award process, and supervises the consulting engineers doing the engineering; recommends change orders and pay requests; assists local agencies during construction, and performs other duties as required.

The position requires graduation from a four year accredited college or university with a degree in civil engineering or other relevant branch of engineering; must be a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Colorado, or be able to transfer out-of-state registration to Colorado; three years experience in responsible engineering work with a consulting engineering firm, construction firm, or public agency, preferably with experience in construction management.

The position requires a working knowledge of hydrology, hydraulics, drainage and floodplain management concepts; working knowledge of the technical and practical aspects of engineering design, and construction management; ability to apply such knowledge and concepts to specific problems; ability to work effectively and cooperatively with other members of the staff and the public; and must possess high levels of both oral and written communication skills; and must have demonstrated interest and ability in maintaining technical proficiency.

Salary range for this position is \$5,301 - \$7,581 per month.
