

The Association of State Floodplain Managers (ASFPM) Certified Floodplain Managers (CFM®) Exam will be offered at Jefferson County Administration Building on 9:00 am April 21st, 2017. The address of the facility is

In order to take the CFM® exam, you must complete and submit the CFM® Program Application Package to the ASFPM. The forms are available on the ASFPM website www.floods.org under the Certification Program tab. The fee for taking the exam is \$100 for ASFPM members and \$450 for non-members. You may submit an application for ASFPM membership at the same time as applying to take the CFM® exam.

Space in the facility is limited to 30 participants, so get your application in early. In order to be accepted to take the CFM® Exam, you must submit your completed application along with the appropriate fee to ASFPM by [April 7, 2017] (2 weeks prior to exam date). No walk-ins will be allowed unless authorized by the ASFPM Executive office.

A Floodplain 101 class will be held, in the same facilities the day before, April 20th, 2017. Both the test and the Floodplain 101 class will be held at the same location and will start at 9:00 am. For both the class and test, please arrive early enough to locate the facility and be settled in. The Jefferson County Administration Building is located at the west end of the RTD light rail W Line.
