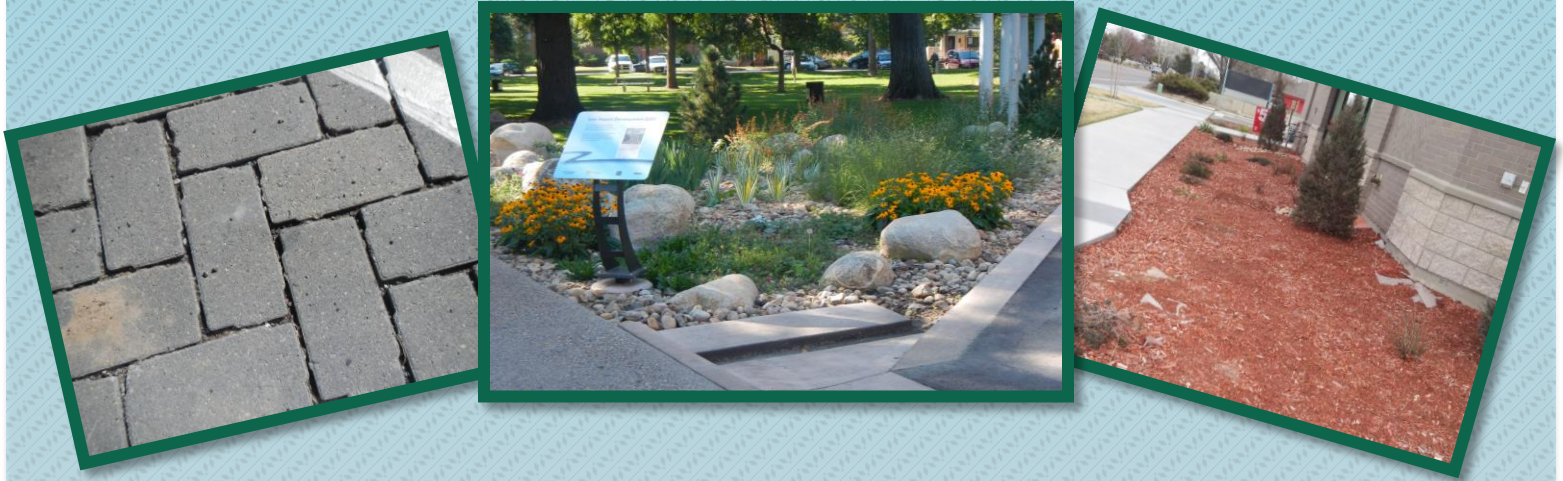


INTRODUCTION TO GREEN INFRASTRUCTURE AND LOW IMPACT DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP
