The selection committee anticipates that emails will be sent out by May 20th notifying you whether or not your submission was selected.

The abstract selection process is competitive; each year we receive more abstracts than time slots available. Due to the level of competition, we will prioritize abstracts with compelling and descriptive content that offer innovative or unique ideas based on the topics identified above. We encourage applicants to get creative with your content and presentation style to improve your chance of being selected.
