# CALL FOR PROJECT AWARDS

## NOMINATIONS FOR OUTSTANDING NON-CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

Beginning in 2020, the Colorado Association of Stormwater & Floodplain Managers (CASFM) Engineering Excellence Project Award was divided into two main categories: Construction and Non-Construction projects. The awards are given in alternating years.

For 2025, CASFM is soliciting Non-Construction project nominees that focus on planning studies, public education programs, flood warning and response plans, criteria manuals, outreach and communication, etc. Eligible entries for the award need to have been completed between May 2023 to May 2025. If there are questions regarding eligibility of your project, please reach out to leff Battiste ahead of submitting (see contact info below).

Eligible entries will be selected for presentation at the 2025 CASFM Conference. Attendees will vote at the conclusion of the presentations, and the entry receiving the most votes will receive the 2025 CASFM Engineering Excellence Project Award.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Entries must be completed between May 2023 and May 2025. Entries may be public or private ownership. Submittals may be made by the designer and/or owner. Entries submitted in previous years are ineligible.

#### **SUBMITTAL MATERIALS**

Submit a project description, three (3) pages maximum. Pages must be 8.5x11", but one of the pages can be in an 11x17" format. The page limit includes tables, figures, photographs, and other graphical representations. An additional cover page can be included that does not count toward the three (3) page maximum. The font size for all included text should be no smaller than 10 point. The submittal may include links to project websites, ArcGIS StoryMaps, or other web-based project information.

### **JUDGING CRITERIA**

Selected entries will be presented at the 2025 Conference. The final nominees will be responsible for a live presentation during the conference. Additional details regarding the presentation and conference formats, along with the presentation schedule, will be provided at a later date.

Successful entries will clearly answer the following:

- 1. Does the project enhance the public health, safety, and welfare? Or does the project provide significant environmental or ecological benefit?
- 2. Does the project incorporate creative, unique, or innovative solutions?
- 3. Can the project serve as a model for other communities and/or projects?
